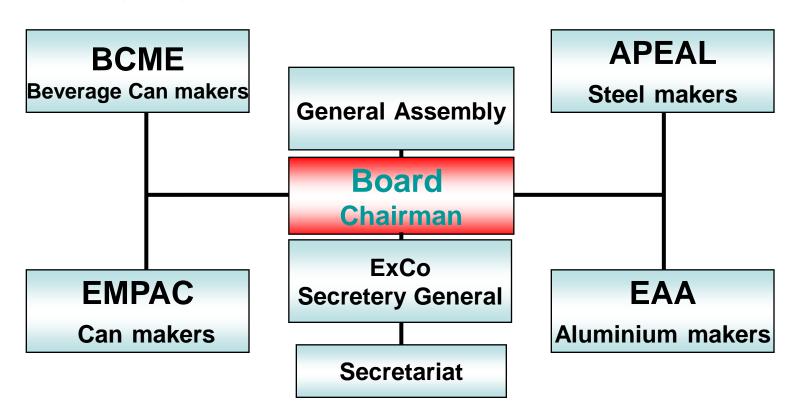

The Manifesto

- A unified sector makes stronger commitments
 - Decouple market growth from resource use
 - No metal packaging should go to landfill
 - Keep all metal packaging in the material loop
 - 80% of metal packaging will be recycled 2020
 - Reduce CO2 emissions and other environmental impacts by dedicated programs and commitments in steel and aluminum production.



Metal Packaging - a new positioning

- Infinite recycling not well recognized downcycling has the same legal status
- Permanent material not recognized renewable and biodegradable materials preferred
- Recycled content fighting rearguard action against policy suited to plastics



Metal Packaging in Policy

- Metal packaging must be properly positioned in "Responsible Resource Management" policy
- Metals should be recognized as permanent materials with infinite recycling possibilities, preserving virgin metal qualities and with unlimited availability for future generations.



False Perception

The polarization of material categories into renewable and non-renewable is misleading and not helpful

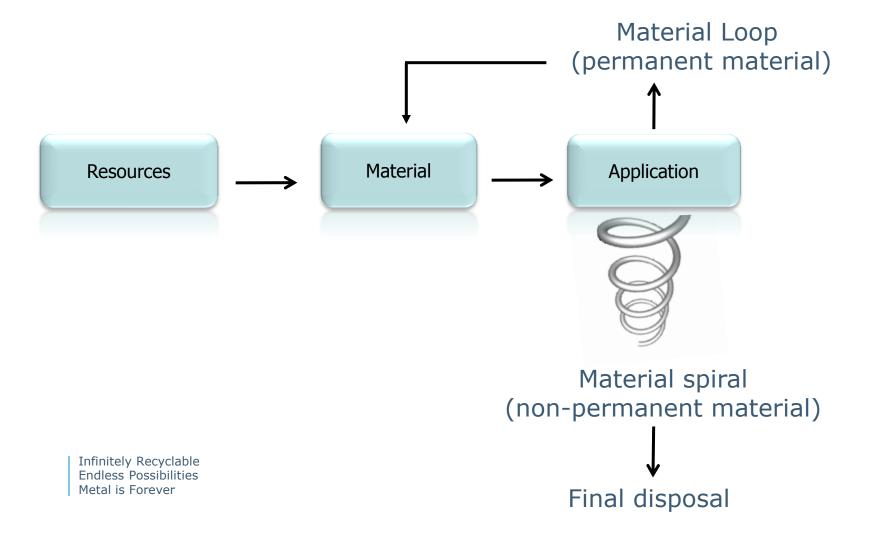
Statements claiming that non-renewable resources are gone, once used, is false in the case of metals. Metal elements are not lost, they change location and appear in different forms



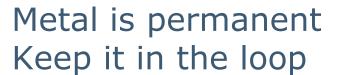




Material management cycle
